



CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY NOTICE

West Bloomfield Township – SAD #161 – Rutledge Park - Roadway Improvement Project

June 13, 2018

Dear Homeowner,

We would like to take this opportunity to advise you of recent developments with respect to the West Bloomfield Township SAD #161 – Rutledge Park – Roadway Improvement Project.

As you are aware, construction of the proposed Roadway Improvement Project is currently underway and progressing well. The contractor is nearly complete with performing the required large-scale full depth roadway and driveway repairs in Phase 2.

Beginning approximately Thursday, June 14th (weather permitting) the contractor will begin installing new asphalt pavement within the large-scale full depth roadway repair areas and driveways. This operation will take approximately 2-3 days to complete.

Once the above repairs are finalized, the contractor will begin performing the final roadway joint repairs, by sawcutting and removing various joints within the remaining existing concrete pavement that are in need of repair. This operation will commence on approximately Monday, June 18th, and will take several days to complete. The contractor will focus their operations for this item on one half (or one lane) of the roadway at a time. Meaning, one lane of the roadway should remain open to vehicle traffic at all times. Access to driveways will be maintained during this operation, unless a temporary closure is required to perform a joint repair directly in front of your drive.

The Construction Inspector from Nowak & Fraus Engineers will notify impacted residents, prior to closing down their driveway, and advise of acceptable alternate parking areas along the roadway. Any on-street parking of vehicles will be prohibited within the area of construction. Residents will be directed to park along ONE side of the roadway, outside the project limits (potentially Ledgeway Drive, Rutledge Park Court, Wynford Drive or Winchester Road)

Mail delivery, garbage collection and emergency vehicle access will be maintained throughout the duration of the project.
