Acetone, Aerosols, Antifreeze, Asbestos, Automotive Fluid, Batteries (Alkaline/Auto/Household), Bug Spray, Chemical Cleaners, Compressed Cylinders, Corrosives (Acid/Bases), Diesel, Expired Medication, Fire Extinguisher, Floor Care Products, Florescent Tubes, Fungicides, Furniture Polish, Gasoline, Herbicides, Insecticides, Kerosene, Lightbulbs, Lighter Fluid, Medical Sharps (in Rigid Containers), Mercury, Metallic, Moth Balls, Motor Oil, Nail Polish, Oil, Oxidizers, Paint & Paint Products, Pesticides, Plastic Shopping Bags, Polishes, Pool Chemicals, Propane Cylinders, Road Flares, Smoke Detectors, Solvents, Thermometers, Varnish, Wood Preservatives.
