ORDINANCE NO. C- 766

MARIJUANA FACILITIES MORATORIUM EXTENSION ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to extend a previously established moratorium on marijuana facilities.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF WEST BLOOMFIELD ORDAINS:

Section 1 of Ordinance

Section 2-703 in Division 1, Marijuana Facilities Moratorium, of Article VII, Moratoriums, in Chapter 2, Administration, of the West Bloomfield Charter Township Code is amended as of the effective date of this Ordinance to read as follows:

Sec. 2-703. Moratorium.

Through August 31, 2013, a moratorium is established and shall be in effect on the consideration, review or action by all Township entities, officials, employees and/or agents on applications, proposals, requests, permits, approvals, zoning compliance or certificates regarding or for marijuana facilities, or for the use and dispensing of marijuana, that might be proposed or presented to the Township as protected or allowed by the MMMA, and that during the moratorium period, no marijuana facility shall be allowed in the township.

Section 2 of Ordinance

Should any section, subdivision, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared by a court to be invalid, that shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any parts not invalidated. All proceedings pending and all rights and liabilities existing, acquired or incurred at the time this ordinance takes effect are saved and may be consummated according to the law in force when they are commenced.

Section 3 of Ordinance

This Ordinance shall be published on or before September 1, 2012 and shall take effect on September 1, 2012.
