



# CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY NOTICE

**West Bloomfield Township – SAD #161 – Rutledge Park - Roadway Improvement Project**

April 26, 2018

Dear Homeowner,

We would like to take this opportunity to advise you of recent developments with respect to the West Bloomfield Township SAD #161 – Rutledge Park – Roadway Improvement Project.

**Construction of the proposed Roadway Improvement Project is currently scheduled to begin the week of April 30, 2018 (weather permitting).**

The contractor will begin mobilizing their equipment and traffic control barricades to the site early in the week, and then commence the required pavement removals / repairs. This means that various areas of the project site will be completely closed to traffic, during working hours. Traffic control barricades will be installed to direct vehicles along alternate routes to access Middlebelt Road or Maple Road.

Access to some driveways may be blocked during working hours, as a result of the required pavement repairs. The Construction Inspector from Nowak & Fraus Engineers will notify impacted residents, prior to closing down their driveway, and advise of acceptable alternate parking areas along the roadway. Any on-street parking of vehicles will be prohibited within the area of construction. Residents will be directed to park along ONE side of the roadway, outside the project limits (potentially Ledgeway Drive, Wynford Drive or Winchester Road)

Residents with roadway repairs in front of their driveway will lose access to their driveway for an approximate one-week period of time, to allow for the placement and curing of new concrete curb and gutter. Again, the Construction Inspector from Nowak & Fraus Engineers will notify impacted residents, prior to closing down the driveway.

The anticipated hours of construction for this project are 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday – Friday and 7:00 am to 7:00 pm on Saturday. At the end of each day, the roadway will be temporarily restored with gravel, and opened to traffic until construction commences on the following morning.

Mail delivery, garbage collection and emergency vehicle access will be maintained throughout the duration of the project.
