CODE OF ORDINANCES – CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE III

TRAFFIC CONTROL IN/ON Aldingbrooke Apartments

(Name of Parking Area/Private)

An ordinance authorizing the Charter Township of West Bloomfield to regulate and control traffic and parking in either the parking areas and/or the private roads of:

Aldingbrooke Apartments

in accordance with the provision of the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 22, Article III of the Charter Township of West Bloomfield, Traffic Control in Parking Areas and on Private Roads Ordinance:

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF WEST BLOOMFIELD ORDAINS:

Section 1. Acceptance of Application

The Township hereby accepts the application of: Betsy Oman

to subject the parking areas, private roads of the said location to the requirements of the code of Ordinances, Chapter 22, Article III, Traffic Control in Parking Areas and on Private Roads Ordinance, which application and plot plan are made a part hereof by reference.

Section 2. Application of Ordinance Provisions

Under the authority granted to it by Chapter 22, Article III of the Code of Ordinances, the Township Board of the Charter Township of West Bloomfield hereby makes all of the provisions and penalties for violations thereof, as contained in Chapter 22, applicable to said location. All of the provisions of Chapter 22 shall be incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

Section 3. Specific Traffic Control Orders

In addition to the provisions of Chapter 22, the following Traffic Control Orders are hereby adopted:

20 M.P.H. Speed Limit Signs should be 24" X 30" for proper visibility and enforcement

Section 4. Application Retained

Said application shall be retained in the permanent records of the Township.

Section 5. Effective Date

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby ordered to take effect thirty (30) days after publication of this Ordinance, or when any necessary signs or traffic control devices are installed, whichever is later.
